Brian Moore, a Fredericton native, studied at UNB and established his company, Fundy Fencing Limited, in 1979. Mr. Moore has been active in community affairs having served as President of the Union Club and Atlantic Fence Industry Association, Commodore of the Royal Kennebecasis Yacht Club and on Saint John's Planning Advisory Committee. At present, he is President of the Cliff Club, Vice-Chairman of the YM-YWCA Endowment Board and a Director of the Miramichi Salmon Association.
